CONDITIONS OF MEMBERS EXHIBITION AT ROCHESTER CONTEMPORARY ART CENTER

- All current members are eligible to enter one artwork in the 30th Annual Members Exhibition. Memberships must be current through the end of the exhibition, expiring January 31, 2021 or later. Artists may join or renew their membership at the time of drop-off: Nov. 6, 12-9pm, Nov. 7 & 8, 12-6pm.
- The 30th Annual Members Exhibition will be open to the public December 4, 2018 - January 9, 2021. Opening Night will be held Friday, Dec. 4, 6-9pm. Rochester Contemporary Art Center will be closed from December 24 through January 1.
- Pick-up dates are Jan. 9, 5-7pm, Jan.10 & 11, 12-6pm. **Artwork left at the Rochester Contemporary Art Center after January 18 will become the property of the Art Center.**
- Please contact RoCo Staff by November 1 to make arrangements for video artworks.
- All artworks entered in the exhibition will be eligible for awards and purchase prizes.
- The Art Center charges a 25% commission on all artwork sales.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center will hold the opening reception Friday, Dec. 4, 6-9pm. Works will be discounted 10% for members. Please price your artworks accordingly.
- Any work sold during an exhibition will remain at the gallery for the duration of the exhibition (January 9, 2021).
- **Each artist is limited to one piece maximum of 32" x 32" x 32" (maximum of 32" in any dimension).**
- Artwork must be delivered ready to exhibit: i.e. appropriately framed, wired, etc.
- The artist is responsible for providing round-trip shipping, packaging, and postal insurance.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center reserves the right to photograph or reproduce artworks for educational purposes, press releases, catalogs, newsletters, or documentation of the exhibition.
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center will present the work(s) as directed by the artist, as faithfully as possible and in a professional manner.
- If the artwork is damaged from transportation, or deterioration is noticed during the exhibition, the Art Center will notify the artist immediately. Rochester Contemporary Art Center will not attempt to repair damaged work without consulting the artist, unless safety to staff or the public warrants such action.
- **Rochester Contemporary Art Center provides replacement cost insurance on damaged or stolen work. Replacement cost refers only to material costs incurred in recreating the artwork. It does not refer to market or sales value.**
- Rochester Contemporary Art Center reserves the right to remove any work(s) from the exhibition.
